Classes

A primary aim this year was to begin Irish language teaching in our Gaeltacht location. For this purpose, we rented a 20' x 20' party tent, which served the purpose admirably.

Síle Scott taught lively classes, both on location, and at the beach in Calabogie. Approximately ten people attended.

Tent City

The social dynamics on location proved very interesting with the larger number of attendees. The tribal nature of the campsite in the open air seemed to bring out the best of our native social instincts. Some people had campers, and others had "crawl-in" pup-tents, but everyone help each other out and worked together — learning Irish, cooking meals, felling

The Saturday night céilí was a great success. Seventeen people were present, there was music, dance, songs and poetry. The party tent was lighted by lanterns, and a campfire was lit outside.

Bathhouse

A very good start has been made in constructing our log bathhouse. The appropriate logs have been felled, and skidded from the woods (Many thanks to Donovan Conlan who provided his 4-wheeler.). The house will be mostly cedar, although some white spruce is also being used.

Many people have assisted with the construction to this point, and so the expertise among our membership is growing. This will stand us in good stead when we undertake more ambitious construction projects.

More work is required to complete the bathhouse. It is important that as much work as possible be done before winter, to prevent rotting. They may begin to rot if they are not properly placed in the walls, and roofed. We would therefore like to organize a work weekend 19-21 September 2003. Please bring your chain saw if you have one.

Mosquitoes

There is no concealing the fact that mosquitoes are plentiful at the Gaeltacht site. We do not currently have the capability to cut the hay, and this creates a veritable haven for these creatures.

Some consideration should be given to acquiring a "mosquito magnet" (see http://www.mosquitomagnetdepot.com/ for instance). This device emits a plume of carbon dioxide, heat, and moisture to attract biting insects, while simultaneously vacuuming the insects into a net where they dehydrate and die. For about \$500.00 we could obtain a device with an acre of coverage. Prices are likely to come down with current concern about the West Nile virus. Perhaps we can borrow or rent one for next year.

It may be of interest to know that the West Nile virus is more likely to be contracted in town than in the county. Although there are more mosquitoes in the country, they are less frequently of the "proper" species to carry the virus.
