# Unique, historical dwellings on display

If you've ever caught yourself passing a striking home just itching to take a peek inside, you can get a chance to do that and more this Saturday.

Beginning at 10 a.m., a summer tour of many of Tamworth's and Erinsville's unique and historical homes is being staged by the twin villages' economic development committee.

Among historical homes and beautiful gardens, the tour will treat visitors to a look inside a "green friendly home" built partly underground.

The tour will also cover the property at 298 Gilmore Rd., the location of the first permanent North American Gaeltacht — designated Irish Gaelic speaking site.

Gaeltacht devotees are wrapping up their annual summer camp and are holding their open house beginning at 11 a.m. They want people to tour their trails, stop and learn a little Gaelige and perhaps watch a Gaelic football game.

Passports for the tour are \$20 and are available at Gray's IDA in Napanee, the River Bakery and Stone Mills Family Market in Tamworth, and Beaver Lake Variety in Erinsville.
